Vale Bill Condon



For about fourteen years (until January of this year), Brisbane Catholic Historical Society's Honorary Auditor was Bill Condon. It came as a great shock to us when Bill died on 4 July 2014, aged 74, following a stroke.

William Michael Condon was born in Warwick and his family moved to Toowoomba the following year. He was educated by the Christian Brothers at St. Mary's College. After graduating, he studied Accountancy at night.

Bill married Yvonne Bennett in 1963 and they had two children: Graham and Cathy. In 1969 the family moved to Brisbane where Bill and Yvonne were very involved in the Zillmere Parish.

Bill's last working position was Finance Manager of Catholic Education, Archdiocese of Brisbane. Part of his responsibility was as a member of a committee travelling throughout Queensland advising on applications by school communities for funding of renovations, expansion, or new schools.

Bill and Yvonne retired in 2000 and moved to Bribie Island.

One problem for the Society's Treasurer—and therefore its Auditor—is that our Financial Year is the Calendar Year and our AGM is held in early February. Bill was very reliable in dropping all other commitments to have the Auditor's Statement, and our books, back to us within a few days. He was an efficient and reliable Auditor and the Brisbane Catholic Historical Society owes him its gratitude.

Bill Condon is survived by Yvonne, their two children and three grandsons.
